In Mommouthshire you can enjoy the trail in short sections or walk the whole 14 mile (22km) length. It's mostly level going other than a few steeper parts in Chepstow. Boots and warm, waterproof clothing are advised.

Join the route at Chepstow, Black Rock, Sudbrook or Caldicot for walks with good links to public transport. At Mathern, Coast Path meets the Tewdring Trail.

Mae Llwybr Arfordir Cymru wedi'i gwneud yn haws nag erioed i ymchwilo arfordir gwych y genedl.



Along Mommouthshire's coastline, a tradition of natural splendour, fascinating traditional panoramic views.

This threshold of Wales has been a strategic place to cross the Severn Estuary since Roman times. Today's magnificent bridges are part of a breathtaking seascape, easily enjoyed at Black Rock viewpoint and picnic site.

With the second highest tidal range in the world, this coast is both natural wonder and special habitat. Every year thousands of migrating birds are attracted to the abundant feeding grounds of the mudflats.

There's a strong sense of history here. Look out for Caldicot's Medieval castle and country park, the sea defences of the Gwent Levels, Chepstow heritage trail and castle, Black Rock's lawe net fishing and Victorian engineering at Sudbrook.

You'll find a variety of shops and services in Magor, Caldicot and Chepstow. The Tourist Information Centre by Chepstow castle is a good starting point for your visit, providing plenty of advice on coastal places to visit, eat, drink and stay.

Shape of a nation

Chepstow is the meeting place of two remarkable long distance trails. The Wales Coast Path follows the nation's 870 mile (1,370km) seaward boundary. Offa's Dyke Path tracks the inland border for 177 miles (285km). Together they complete the circuit of Wales.
